CHAPTER 80
VILLAGE BOARD

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF ELM GROVE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: §80-3 Village Board – Standing advisory committees of the Village of Elm Grove Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by the addition of underlined text.

§80-3 Standing advisory committees

A. The following shall constitute the standing advisory committees of the Village Board to which there shall be referred, when deemed advisable, questions pertaining to the subject matter appearing under the designation of such committees, as follows, and such other subjects as may be referred to such committees by action of the Village Board. The terms of such committees shall be for a period of one year and shall extend to the third Tuesday of April of each year. No non-trustee member of a standing committee shall serve more than ten (10) consecutive terms on any standing committee unless a two thirds majority of the Village Board approves of said appointment.

Section 2: If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remainder of such ordinance.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage. However; upon passage of this ordinance all standing advisory committees with more than one person serving longer than the prescribed term shall have those members terms staggered such that no more than one person shall be removed from said standing advisory committee in any given year unless a two thirds majority of the Board of Trustees agrees to said removal.
