## WATERCOLOR 101

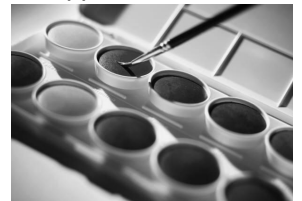
