The monthly drill will be extrication, two cars will be available.

D.C. Hand reported 14 calls for June. The ART was 6.5 minutes with 11.5 firefighters responding. These numbers are down from our monthly averages. Calls consisted of 5 false alarms, 3 arching wires, 1 rescue call, 1 service call, 1 smoke, 1 MVA, 1 mutual aid and 1 alarm malfunction.

Brian Naylor is looking for some volunteers to remove the furniture in the dayroom and offices for the carpet cleaning project.

The picnic is Sunday, August 7th. There will be pool passes for swimming available from Paula. The pool is open 1-8 pm. Dinner will be served at 4:30 pm.

Chief Selzer thanked everyone who participated in the various Fourth of July activities, whether for mutual aid departments or in the Village Park.

Chief Selzer showed a power point of OASIS, a new radio system that will be coming to Waukesha and Milwaukee counties. Radio talk groups were reviewed.

Chief Selzer ended the meeting with a video of the recent water rescue drill. He would like to create a video library of trainings or SOG's.
