

Fire Department Village Board Report Narrative

Month: December

Activities for the Month: The activities included equipment and station maintenance and our Annual Christmas Party at the Firehouse.

Training: The department conducted ice/water rescue training, driver training and the City of Waukesha conducted Hazmat and Special Teams training including; trench rescue, building collapse and shoring, high and low angle rescue and confined space rescue.

Projects: The department is currently working on or has completed the following projects:

- Updating of our MABAS Box Cards which will go into effect in late December or early January.
- Updating of our Standard Operating Guidelines for the Downtown area and Squires Grove.

Calls for Service: There were 15 calls for service comprised of: 8 false alarms with 2 due to a snow/wind storm, 2 cooking related, 4 detector head or system malfunctions, 2 arcing wires calls, 1 Mutual Aid to the City of Brookfield and 1 to the Village of Menomonee Falls, 1 vehicle fire, 1 vehicle accident and 1 electrical problem.

Year to date the calls for service are 1 behind with the false alarms being 4 ahead last year.




2012 Fire Calls

120 YTD




Average Response Time (Minutes)

6.3 Local / 14.5 Mutual Aid / 7.4 YTD AVG




Average Turnout

14.1 AVG




Fire Call Man Hours



2012 Annual Fire Report

The calls-for-service over past four years have been within a call or two of each other. The major difference between 2011 and 2012 was a nine call reduction in mutual aid responses. This is mainly due to the City of Wauwatosa changing their response cards and moving Elm Grove to the Box Alarm level from the Full Still which requested Elm Grove earlier in a fire event.

The Elm Grove Volunteer Fire Department strives to maintain a highly trained organization with a focus on safety and fire prevention. The support given by the Village Board, Joint Services, and Village Staff members has given the department the tools and support needed to attain and maintain our service goals.
