HOUSE FIRE – 15105 Westover Road, ELM GROVE

On Monday, April 23, 2012, at approximately 2:52 AM, Elm Grove Police and Fire Departments responded to an active house fire, at the above location. The structure is a single family home that, at the time of this release, is believed to have been unoccupied and is for sale.

The home did have an accepted offer, with the sale scheduled for closing on today's date.

All evidence at the scene, along with all information gained through interviews of the homeowners, their agents, and the prospective buyers, and their agents, indicates that the home was vacant and that no one was in the residence.

The State of Wisconsin Fire Marshal has been called in to assist with this investigation. The purpose of the investigation is to determine an origin of the fire. At some point, fire investigators, with the homeowner's insurance company, may be able to narrow the investigation to determine a cause of the fire.
