### HOUSE FIRE – 13165 Wrayburn Rd, Elm Grove

On Wednesday, July 1, 2015, at 10:25 AM, Elm Grove Police and Fire Departments responded to an active residential house fire at 13165 Wrayburn Rd, in Elm Grove. The first responding fire command and police units arrived within one minute of the call and observed white and grey smoke coming from the roof of the residence.

The fire involved a single family home. The home was not occupied at the time, however contractors were on scene repairing a flat rubber roof. The fire was contained to the attic and upper side walls of the residence. Investigators are currently on scene investigating the fire. There were no reported injuries to citizens or emergency personnel.
