Hi Tom. I'm glad we could talk tonight regarding the proposed bike path along Watertown Plank Rd. I want to e-mail you reiterating our support for this project.

We have lived on Watertown Plank Rd since August 2015. Prior to purchasing, I met with Casey Griffiths to discuss any future Village plans for our area. He indicated that the recreation master plan included a proposed bike path extension from Highland to Pilgrim. He also indicated that this segment of path extension was the top priority for path construction. This was terrific news to receive, as we liked the house but were concerned with the safety of Watertown Plank Rd. The future path extension was a contributing factor to us closing on the home.

Fast forward to this spring. We are very happy to hear that the Village now plans to proceed with the path extension. We appreciate that the proposed layout puts some space between the road and the path. The current on-road 'path' is not particularly safe. We acknowledge that path construction may impact a portion of our landscape. We'll happily trade a few Arborvitae for the path, although we will appreciate if the consultant engineer finds a way to minimize work limits and disturbance.

Please keep us advised of progress, or if there are future meetings where we need to come voice our support.
