Good afternoon, David.

This is in response to the subject letter sent to my residence this week. There was a request for feedback to be sent to your email address.

I have a couple of questions: first, of course, is who will bear the cost of the cul de sac construction? And second, what is the supposed impact to the Underwood Creek Bridge? This is mentioned but not elaborated on in the letter.

My general observation is that there is very little traffic in or out of the Underwood Parkway and North Ave intersection currently, and therefore I fail to see the value added in construction of a cul de sac. Furthermore this will have the trade-off of increased traffic to both the Lilly and Mt Kisco intersections with North Ave, which invites other potential issues.

In short I oppose this proposal for a cul de sac at Underwood Parkway, as the negatives, including potential cost impact to residents of Elm Grove, outweigh the presumed benefits as I understand them.
