Hello, Please read this to the board.

Thanks for your explanation & asking of our opinion. We understand the reasoning of closing the Underwood street but do not agree with it.

We feel there are only two exits for the majority of homes on this side of the creek.

One day I could not exit Mt Kisco because of accident debris, lots of glass, right as I would of exited Mt Kisco getting on North. I was glad I could use Underwood as an alternate. If Underwood is closed that only gives us 2 viable exits from this side of the creek.

Now with the North Ave. construction, it maybe possible that Mt Kisco will be not always available, then we are down to one ^{entrance} exit, over the creek and out Hwy. That's cutting it pretty tight for 30 some homes w/ fire & other emergency vehicles. This area in our opinion is somewhat land locked, I don't feel it to our benefit to add to Mt Kisco's congestion or limit our emergency vehicle accessibility.

Please consider not closing Underwood,

Also, if Underwood is ending up closed, I feel Elm Grove should take on the green space along the creek that Village Green currently maintains as a trade-off.
