Hello David,

I am writing to let you know I do not favor the cul de sac proposal you recently discussed in your letter of June 14, 2018. I have been watching the problems we have on Mount Kisco Drive when entering North Avenue in attempt to go in either direction. I believe the Elm Grove police (as well as Brookfield police) are aware of the speeding that takes place on North Ave between Highland Avenue and Lily Road, as I see police stopping drivers regularly. However, without police presence, it is extremely difficult to enter North Ave from Mount Kisco Drive due to the speeding on North Avenue. I believe this will become much worse if traffic is diverted from Underwood Creek Parkway to Mount Kisco Drive. It will only be a matter of time before someone is seriously injured or killed while attempting to enter North Avenue from Mount Kisco Drive if all traffic from the Village Green Court area north are to have a single street for access out of our particular subdivision.

I hope you will consider the safety of our subdivision and the driving hazards we face on a daily basis when making a decision about this matter.
