Gentlemen,

I'm not sure who the correct contact would be for this concern so I am sending it to all of you in the hope it will make it to the right individual(s).

My wife and I often walk the pedestrian path along Watertown Plank road. Our concern is the section between Katherine Drive and west to 13760 Watertown Plank Road as there is no grass strip or buffer between the roadway and pedestrian path. A distracted driver could easily and unknowingly drift into the pathway and strike pedestrians.

As the walkway is going to be repaved soon, I was wondering if it would be possible to install a thin rumble strip at the edge of the asphalt near the roadway. I've seen this often down the center line of newer two lane highways. I believe it would be a very cost effective safety feature.
