Elm Grove Village Pool Rescue

On July 10, 2019, at approximately 2:48 PM, Elm Grove Police and EMS were dispatched to the Elm Grove Village Pool for a report of a subject who was drowning and rescued by a lifeguard.

The victim, a 3 year old Elm Grove male, appeared to be in the water, alone and unsupervised, for approximately 3 minutes. After floating into deeper water, the child becomes submerged repeatedly and eventually extends his arm out of water while being fully submerged, when he was identified by lifeguards as needing emergency assistance.

A lifeguard then entered the pool and carried the child out of the pool, where pool staff provided cardiac chest compressions. The victim then expelled fluids from his mouth and began breathing on his own. The child was transported to Children's Hospital, by Elm Grove Emergency Medical Services.

This incident remains under investigation and is being reviewed by the Waukesha County District Attorney's Office.

No further information will be released until the investigation concludes.
