Dave,

My husband and I have been residents of Kurtis Drive for exactly ten years as of last week. What a gift it is for us to raise our family in EG. There's a piece of desirable infrastructure that is notably absent though, and that is the continuation of installation of paths along some of our busiest roads. For our family the most notable is along Highland, where cars travel above the speed limit and there is no shoulder for pedestrian or bicycle traffic.

We appreciate the cost to install and maintain the paths is not inconsequential, however it is our understanding that accurate bids have not been secured. It is completely reasonable to secure accurate pricing for each of the desired pathways and begin to integrate them into the Village budget. It is completely reasonable to find out whether any newly released federal funding could be applied to these important infrastructure projects. And it is completely reasonable for us as residents and parents to ask for this work to be completed before a pedestrian or cyclist is hit on our Village roads.

Please encourage the Trustees to move ahead with the legitimate research into such projects in 2021.
