One of the main reasons that we moved to Elm Grove was because of the parks and schools and how close everything is. We currently live on Lee Ct near the corner of Hollyhock Ln. We have grown very concerned about walking to the park as a family. Hollyhock Ln is a through street with a number of blind corners. This leads to cars driving fast and pedestrians sharing the road. Next year, my daughter will be starting 4K at Tonawanda and we are not comfortable with us or her walking to school in that scenario. Adding pedestrian pathways that can connect the school to the North side of the village is a great opportunity to connect the entire community.

I understand that this is something that is an investment and needs exploration, so I am asking that this is at least put in the budget so we can estimate what the true cost is and if there are options to do this. Instead of pushing this off, this would be a great opportunity.
