We are contacting you to urge you to prioritize the pedestrian pathways that have been proposed here in Elm Grove, including additional paths along Gebhardt, Highland, Gremoor, Hollyhock, and Juneau east of the park up to Watertown Plank Road. We ask that pathways are prioritized according to the current safety concerns and which receive the most car traffic and use by pedestrians and bikers. These paths would link all parts of the village to downtown, Village park, and local schools. We believe that these pathways are critical to improving the safety and well-being of our children and community members and promoting increased accessibility for all.

Please make this project a priority by:

- 1. Getting the actual cost of path completion.**
- 2. Make the miles of proposed pathway completion a budget item.**
