Sir,

After reviewing and discussing the plans for the Mandel Group development, I concur with the concerns raised in maintaining public safety, specifically;

- The emergency access, from Watertown Plank Road, must be maintained during the winter months (i.e. snowplowed).
- The emergency access must be clearly marked to prevent emergency vehicles from driving off of properly supported access areas.
- The emergency access must be able to adequately support multiple emergency support vehicles, in case that area is utilized to for staging or multiple pieces of equipment are parked on that access area.
- All pedestrian pathways must be wide enough and constructed of a strong enough base to accommodate an ambulance and/or fire equipment for emergency access to remote areas.
- I anticipate that police related calls will be limited. However, our police officers do respond to all ambulance calls. Since this is the case, police officers will respond along with ambulance personnel, based on the estimates provided by EMS Director, Dr. Jon Robinson.
