Structure Fire- 13320 Bluemound Rd., Elm Grove, WI

On Tuesday, January 11, 2022, at approximately 10:30 AM, Elm Grove Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services responded to an active fire at a 4 unit condominium building at 13320 Bluemound Rd., Elm Grove. A resident who resides on the second floor called to report that their porch had caught fire. The first responding police units and fire command unit arrived at approximately 10:34 AM and observed heavy smoke and flames emitting from the second floor of the building. The fire quickly spread to the attic area of the building, causing significant damage to the second floor.

The fire involved a 4 unit condominium. Fire investigators are still on scene investigating the fire. Three units were occupied by three individuals at the time of the fire. The fourth unit was unoccupied at time of fire. All occupants exited from the residence on their own through the front door. There were no injuries to residents or emergency personnel.

The fire necessitated a 2nd level box alarm, consisting of the following fire agencies:

The fire is still under investigation. Estimated structural loss is unknown. Total assessed value of the 4 units including land is \$536,800, according to the 2021 assessment.
