Structure Fire- 755 Terrace Drive, Elm Grove, WI

On Sunday, March 6th, 2022, at approximately 1:26 AM, Elm Grove Police, Fire, and Emergency Medical Services responded to an active structure fire at 755 Terrace Drive, Elm Grove. An Elm Grove Public Works employee, who had been working in the area to remove downed trees from the storm, spotted the fire and immediately contacted Elm Grove Dispatch. The first responding police units and fire command unit arrived at approximately 1:29 AM and observed heavy smoke and flames emitting from the roof of the building. The fire quickly spread through the attic area of the building, due to high winds.

The fire involved a single family style home. However, the building is owned by Elm Grove Lutheran Church and is currently being used as a daycare facility. Due to the time of the incident, the daycare was closed and there were no occupants in the building during the incident. Fire investigators are still on scene investigating the fire. There were no injuries to residents or emergency personnel.
