



UPDATE -- MEDIA RELEASE

HOUSE FIRE – 14905 WISCONSIN AVE., ELM GROVE

On Sunday, January 8, 2012, at approximately 12:26PM, Elm Grove Police and Fire Departments responded to an active house fire, at the above location, which was reported by an elderly female subject, from within the home, via 911.

Our agency, along with assistance from the Wisconsin State Fire Marshall's Office and the Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco and Firearms (ATF), have determined that the source of the fire was located in a west side sun room of the residence. Investigators have ruled out any criminal implications. The fire scene has been released to insurance investigators to determine a cause of the fire.

The female victim of this fire remains hospitalized. Her condition and identity will not be released until family members from out of state are able to meet with authorities to positively identify the female victim.

The members of the Elm Grove Police, Fire and EMS Departments, extend our thoughts and prayers to the fire victim and her family.

We also extend our thanks and appreciation to the agencies indicated in our initial release for their assistance, along with the Wisconsin State Fire Marshall's Office and the ATF.
