Notice is hereby given that the Village of Elm Grove will receive sealed Bids through the online electronic bid service at [www.QuestCDN.com](http://www.QuestCDN.com) for the Highland Drive Pathway Project until 9:00 AM on April 9, 2026. At that time, Bids received will be publicly opened and read at Village Hall, 13600 Juneau Boulevard, Elm Grove, WI.

Project involves approximately 4,795 L.F. of 6-foot wide asphalt pathway construction. Work items include excavation, grading, storm sewer, landscape retaining walls, base aggregate placement, concrete curb & gutter, concrete sidewalk, ADA ramp construction, asphalt paving, clearing & grubbing, pavement marking, landscape restoration and other miscellaneous items in conformance to the Contract Documents including a mandatory alternate section.
