RE: Watermain Project/Closure of Elm Grove Road

This letter is to inform you that the Village of Elm Grove will be installing a watermain on Wall Street and Elm Grove Road during the months of June and July. This project is being done to provide water service to the new senior living project on Wall Street and is expected to be completed by the end of August. The project consists of watermain construction down Elm Grove Road from Bishops Lane in Brookfield to Wall Street and all of Wall Street.

Currently the contractor expects to start work beginning May 28<sup>th</sup>. I have enclosed a copy of the memo provided to the Public Works/Utilities Committee regarding the project which contains a more specific contractor provided schedule and details.

Traffic on Wall Street will be maintained open at all times with some possible delays. Elm Grove Road will be closed to through traffic once the contractor reaches the intersection of Wall Street and Elm Grove Road. The road will remain closed to through traffic until they are off road with construction and the road is considered safe for travel. It is expected that this closure should last approximately two weeks without any unforeseen issues.

Access will be maintained to all homeowners and businesses in the closed area of the road but there will be no through traffic allowed during that time. Detour signs will be posted with the official detour route being Sunnyslope and Watertown Plank Road.

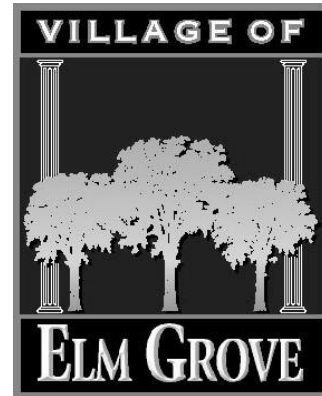
The Village appreciates your patience and apologizes for the inconvenience but we are hopeful that this project will go quickly and be a minimal disruption this summer.

**Re:** Watermain Construction Schedule Update

---

The Village held the preconstruction meeting for the watermain project on May 14<sup>th</sup>. At this time it is the contractor's intention to start on May 28<sup>th</sup> and be completed with restoration, except final asphalt which will be completed in 2014, by July 19<sup>th</sup>. The provided schedule below is the current best estimate of construction timing for the project. Wall Street will not be closed during construction but there will be lane restrictions. Elm Grove Road will not be closed until such time as they reach the intersection of Elm Grove Road and Wall Street and will be closed until they are past Dunleith Circle and are off road and it is deemed safe to reopen. Obviously this is their best estimate of construction timing based on their experience and may change based on many different factors most notably weather conditions.

May 28 Install Traffic Control  
May 29 Install Erosion Control Measures  
May 30-31 Saw Cutting  
June 3-5 Dig pits for Directional Drill  
June 6-14 Drill under Bluemound Road  
June 17-21 Drill under Elm Grove Road  
June 24-28 Drill under Underwood Creek  
June 6-28 Install mainline starting at Wall Street  
July 1-5 Pressure test and gather samples  
July 8 Tie in existing main  
July 9-19 All Restoration
